


One-Stop Partner Requirements: Provide job seekers access to programs and activities.


One-Stop Operator: Track referrals and lead Partners in the delivery of individualized follow-up career/life services.

#### Applications by Month






Partner Referrals: February 2024 – April 2024






Partner Referrals: February 2023 vs. February 2024






Partner Referrals: March 2023 vs. March 2024
