


One-Stop Partner Requirements: Provide job seekers access to programs and activities.


One-Stop Operator: Track referrals and lead Partners in the delivery of individualized follow-up career/life services.

Applications by Month






Partner Referrals: March 2024 – May 2024






Partner Referrals: March 2023 vs. March 2024






Partner Referrals: April 2023 vs. April 2024

Service Integration Success Story



Adela from College of DuPage (COD) was working with a WIOA youth client, Mohammad S. who is pursuing a Computer and Information Technology Degree at COD. He initially decided not to enroll at workNet because he was receiving financial aid grants. He ran into trouble when he did not have enough financial aid to pay for textbooks. He decided to enroll at workNet and worked with Dezirae, a Youth Counselor. Mohammed registered for class but needed the textbooks before he was able to be approved for the grant. Dezirae brought this to Adela's attention and working with the student we were able to provides funds through the COD CTE Textbook Support program, funded by the Perkins grant. He received \$250 to purchase his textbook and is being funded through the combination of WIOA and financial aid grants moving forward.
