- Uncover Opportunities: Many jobs are shared through word of mouth and referrals.







WRITE SCRIPTS



Take time to write out what you'll say before reaching out. It builds confidence and clarity.

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PREPARING FOR THE CONVERSATION



Before the Chat:

- Research their role and company
- Prepare 5–7 thoughtful questions
- Know your goals, interests, and background
- Be ready to take notes









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Career Journey & Role

- What led you to this role, and how did your career path unfold?
- What does a typical day or week look like in your role?
- What skills or personal qualities are most important in your work?

Industry Trends & Insights

- What trends or changes are shaping your industry right now?
- How has your role or field changed over time?
- What publications would you recommend I subscribe to if I want to stay current on this industry's trends?

Advice for Job Seekers

- What advice would you give someone who's trying to break into this field?
- If you were starting over, what would you do differently?

Growth & Opportunities

• Is there anyone else you think I should speak with to learn more?










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- Start with appreciation.
- Be curious and conversational—not scripted.
- Let them do most of the talking, but be ready to share your interests when asked.
- Wrap up on time and thank them again.








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SEND A THANK YOU EMAIL



- Send it within 24 hours of the conversation.
- Keep it short and specific. 2–3 sentences is enough.
- Mention something you found valuable or insightful.
- Reaffirm your appreciation and interest in staying connected.

Keep the connection warm!

Comment on LinkedIn posts
Send occasional greetings








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BEST PRACTICES & CONTROL OF THE PRACTICES & CONT
