The plan states that the “legal notice regarding the required 30-day Public Comment period <i>will be</i> published in the Daily Herald, DuPage County’s primary newspaper. Additionally, the draft Plan <i>will be</i> available on the workNet DuPage website (www.worknetdupage.org) for viewing and comments.” It appears that this content is out of date as the site shows the plan having been uploaded for public comment for weeks, soliciting comments by March 18, 2020 at the latest.
