

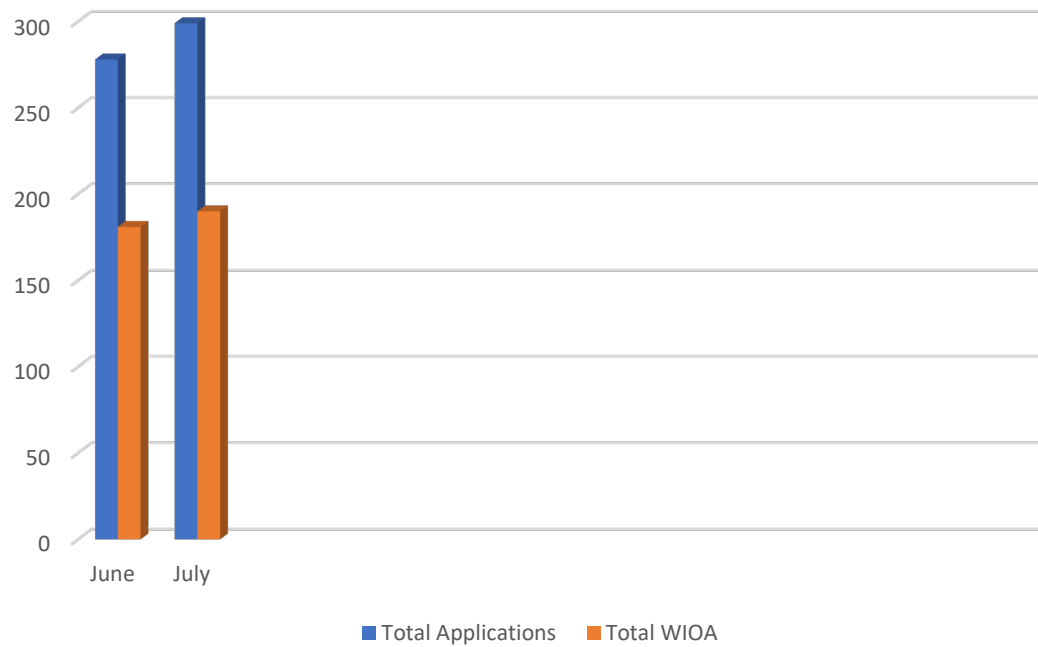


One Stop Operator Report: August 2022

One Stop Partner Requirements: Provide job seekers access to programs and activities

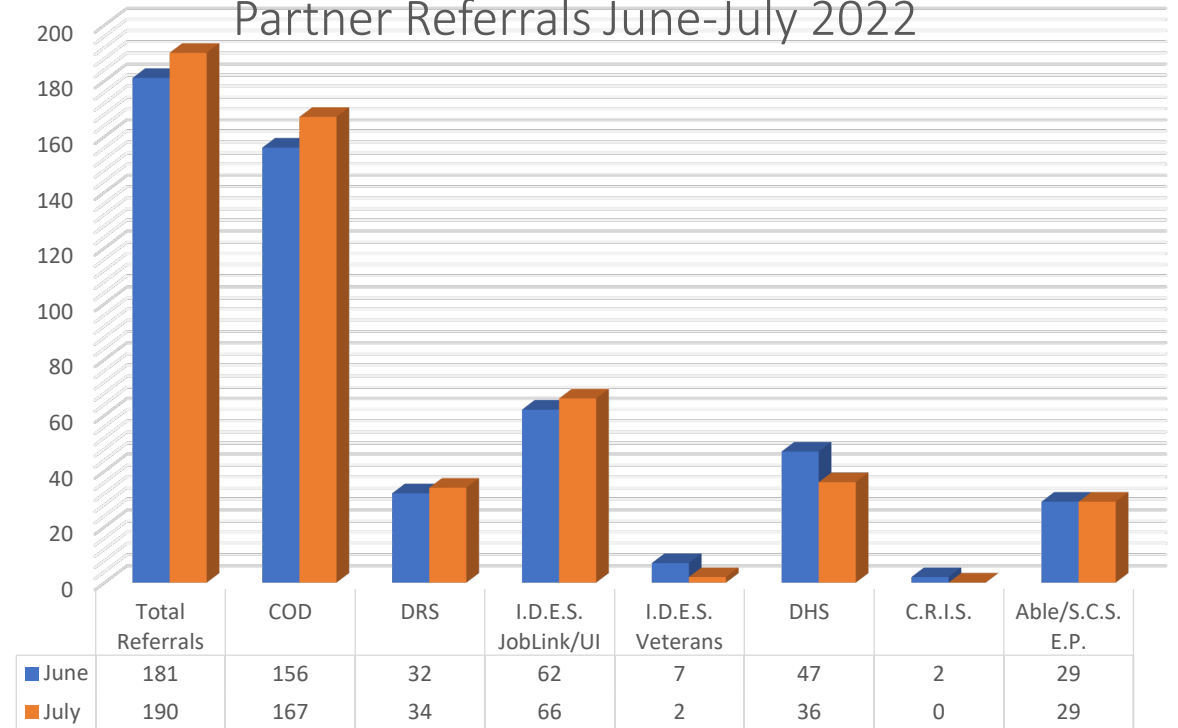
One Stop Operator: Track referrals and lead Partners in the delivery of individualized follow-up career / life services.

Service Integration Success Story: June 2022

Service Integration Success Story June 2022:

Client was referred from workNet DuPage to COD. Referral was seeking her CCNA certification.

She received assistance from a workNet DuPage Career Counselor who completed the vendor certification paperwork. Due to billing requirements monies for the certification test are required upfront.

This student did not have the monies needed to pay for the test. COD staff worked on a backup plan for this student to access emergency funds.

workNet DuPage career counselor worked on finding financial resources; counselor was successful in arranging for workNet DuPage to pay directly for testing.
