

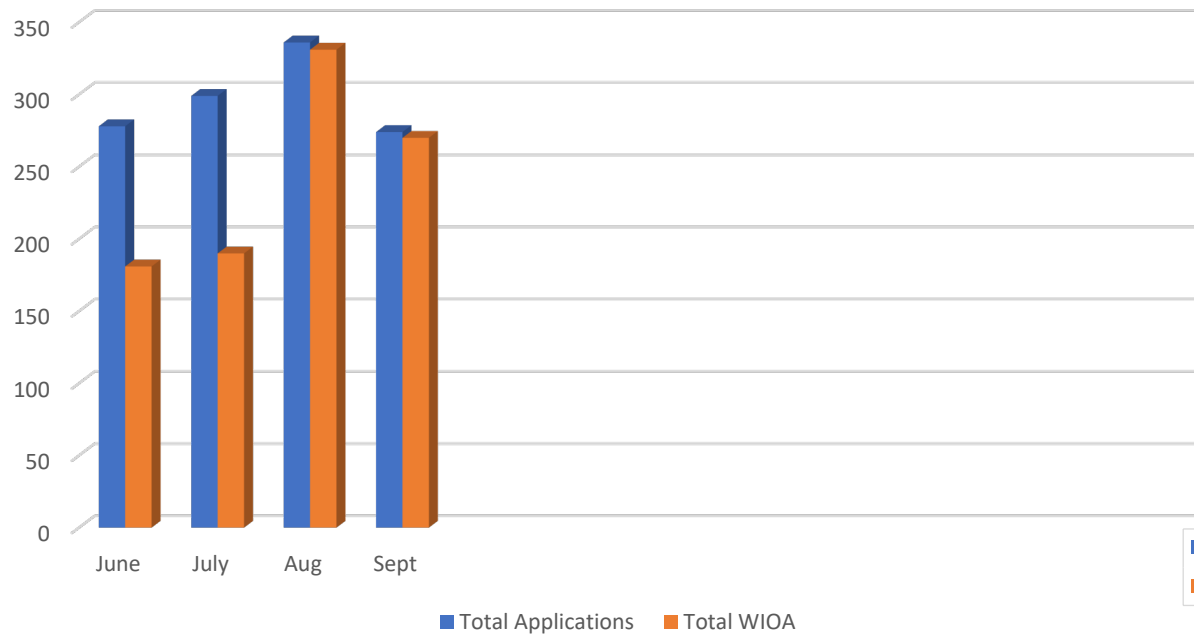


One Stop Operator Report: October 2022

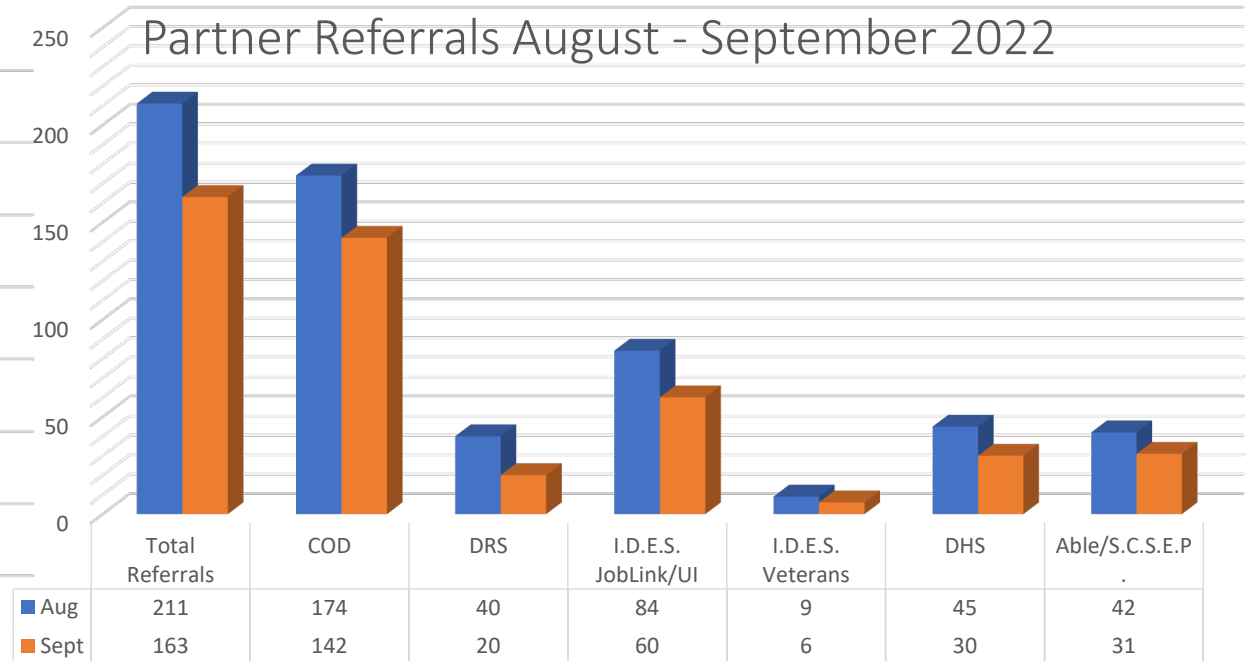
One Stop Partner Requirements: Provide job seekers access to programs and activities

Herman: IDES/Veteran Partner initially referred Tyeshia "Ty" H. to workNet DuPage and Adela: COD. Ty is a veteran seeking assistance in her employment search.

Both Herman and Adela were able to coordinate their appointments to ensure that Ty would only have to come to the office once. This is one of the main purposes of the One Stop Center; multiple agencies under one roof to ensure the user experience is easier to navigate.

IDES/Veteran Partner is providing assistance in Ty's employment search and COD Partner is providing assistance in exploring training opportunities; Computer Information Technology and Health Technology.

Ty has also received a link to Career Coach; an online assessment tool to assist her in determining what career path she may pursue.

In addition to the above assistance Ty is scheduled to meet with a workNet DuPage Counselor next month.
