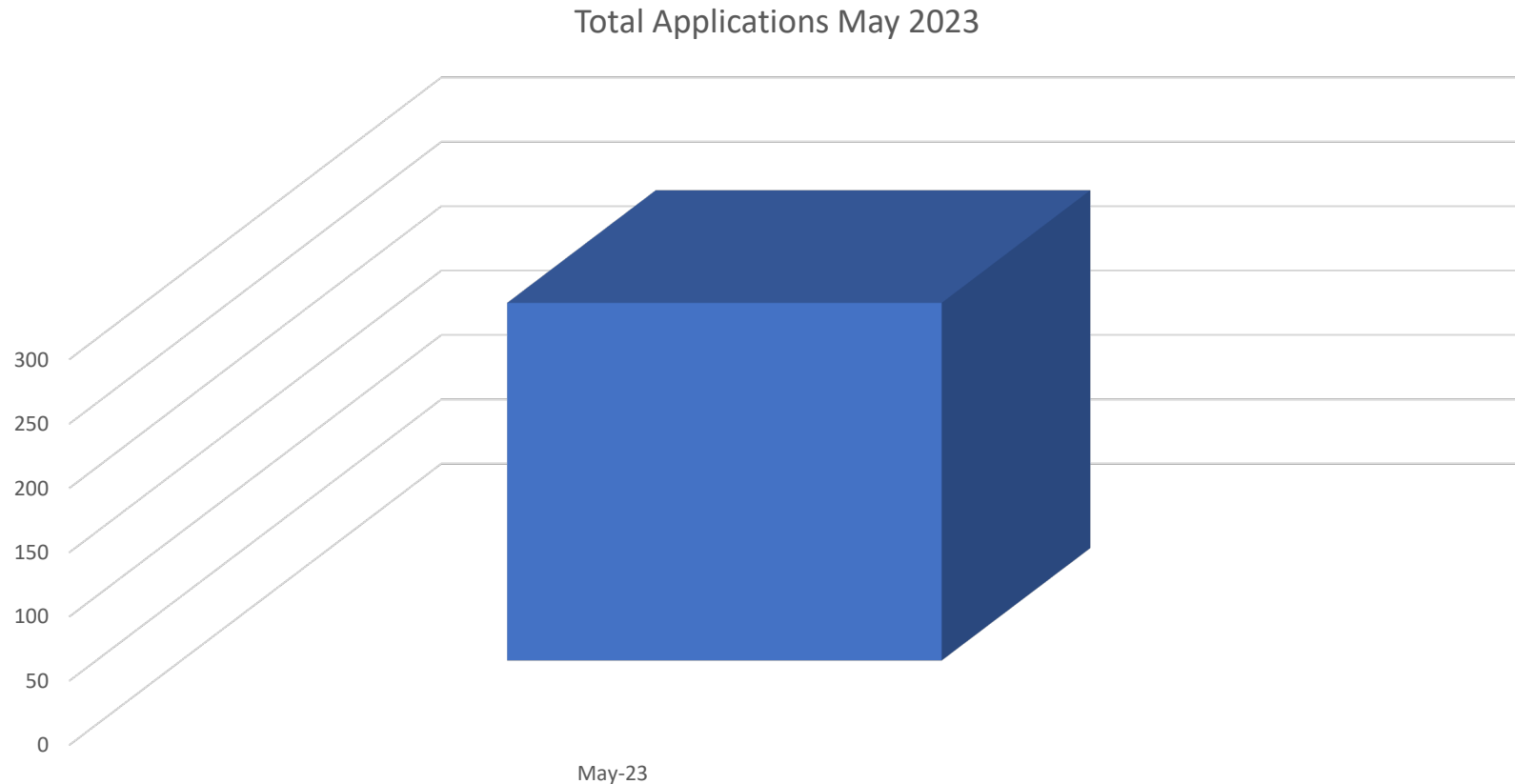

One Stop Operator: Track referrals and lead Partners in the delivery of individualized follow-up career / life services.

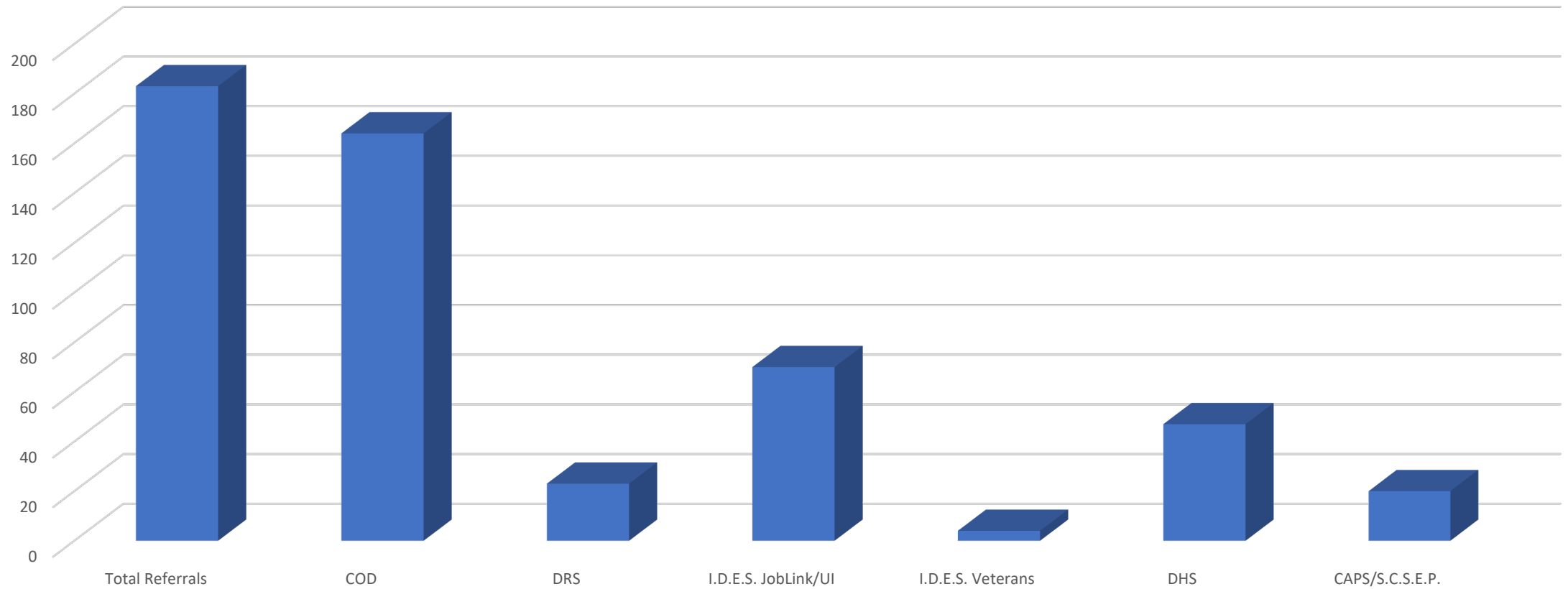


Applications Steady

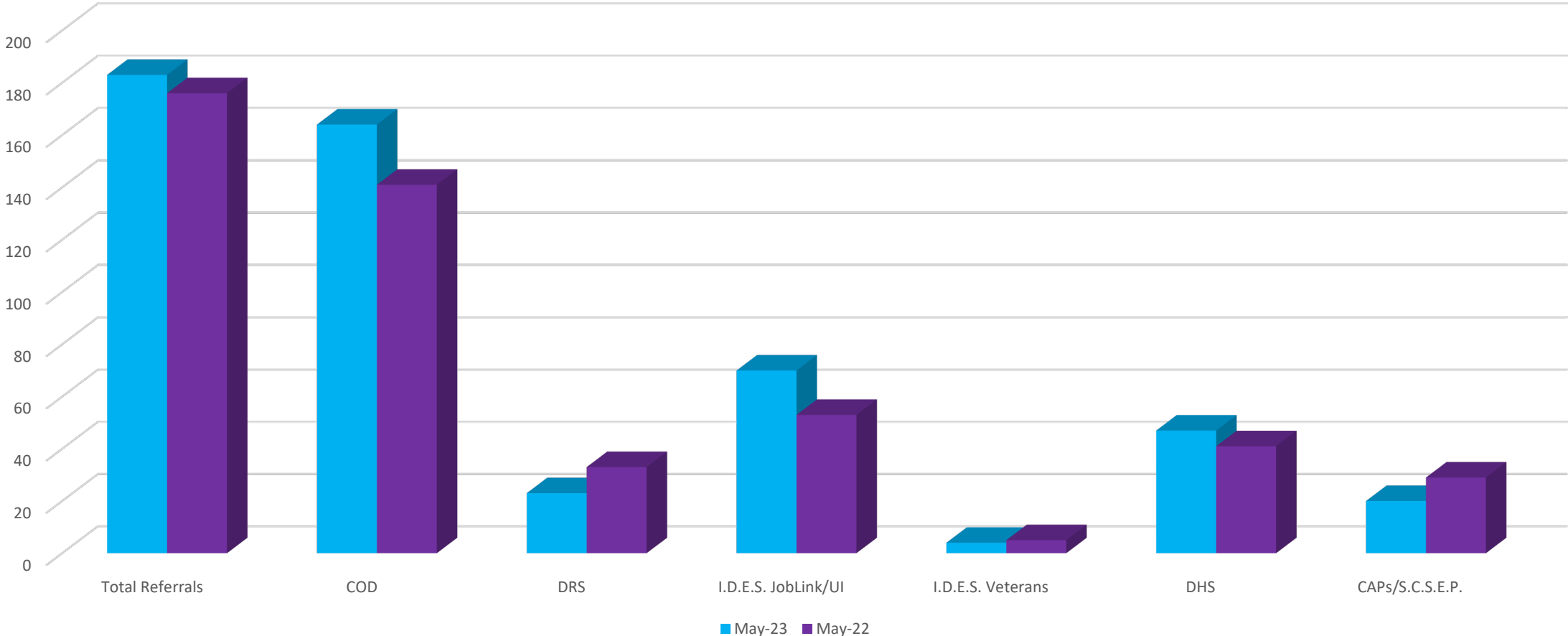
May 2023

Service Integration Success Story May 2023:

Israel G came to the workNet DuPage office on June 1, 2023, requesting assistance with his unemployment claim. He met with Matt, our IDES Partner who in addition to assisting with the unemployment claim offered employment services including the creation of a resume.

During the interview, Israel mentioned that due to a back injury he could no longer work at his previous occupation; working in an auto part store where heavy lifting is required. He mentioned that he had applied for disability benefits.

Matt let Israel know that our Partner, Department of Rehabilitation Services, has a staff member working on site. Israel was introduced to Michael, Department of Rehabilitation Services, and spent time learning what services are offered.

Israel is now working with both Matt and Michael.
